

Plantation Pipe Line Company will be conducting a test movement of blended B-5 biodiesel in the near future in order to assess the operational viability of transporting this renewable fuel through its system. The batch will be specifically identified within the normal ultra low sulfur diesel sequence and transported in the CNG pipeline. The CNG pipeline extends from Collins MS to Greensboro, NC with several intermediate delivery locations. No aviation fuel is currently transported in the CNG pipeline.

As with all our operations, this initiative has been developed with the requirement to preserve the quality of all customers' products. Comprehensive sampling, analysis and operational oversight will ensure a safe, efficient movement from which we expect to derive useful information.
