Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (ICA) and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (F.E.R.C.), Plantation Pipe Line Company (Plantation) submits for filing four copies of the following tariff, effective April 6, 2009 on two days notice:

- F.E.R.C. No. 143, Rules and Regulations (Cancels F.E.R.C. No. 131)

Plantation is filing this tariff to revise its tariff to include the pipeline transportation of biodiesel as defined under Item 10.18 Petroleum Products. Plantation will accept injection of neat biodiesel into Shippers' ultra-low sulfur diesel (ULSD) as the ULSD begins movement in Plantation's gasoline mainline immediately downstream of Plantation's breakout tankage at Collins, Mississippi. Shipper must meet product specifications as outlined in Item 30 of this Rules and Regulations tariff and as detailed in the Customer Information Manual dated April 6, 2009.

This tariff is being filed in response to shipper interest in the movement of biodiesel on Plantation. The contemplated transportation will occur under existing tariff rates and, therefore, will not involve any change in those rates.

Plantation requests the waiver of the 30-day filing requirement pursuant to 6(3) of the ICA and 18 CFR § 341.14 to file FERC No. 143 on 2 day's notice to be effective April 6, 2009. This filing is made on less than 30-day notice due to the recently completed discussions with Shippers who want to take advantage of the new service as soon as possible. Plantation understands that FERC No. 143 is conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a 30-day review period.

We are also enclosing herewith one additional copy of this transmittal, including all attachments, and respectfully request that it be stamped at the time of filing with the Commission's file stamp and returned for our records.


