Oil Pipeline Filing

Dear Secretary Salas:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (ICA) and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (F.E.R.C.), Plantation Pipe Line Company (Plantation) submits for filing four copies of the following tariffs, effective April 1, 2007:

- F.E.R.C. No. 125, Rules and Regulations (Cancels F.E.R.C. 124)
- F.E.R.C. No. 126, Local, Proportional and Volume Incentive Tariff (Cancels F.E.R.C. No. 123)

Plantation is making this filing for the following reasons:

- The Customer Information Manual date in footnote ① of the Rules and Regulations tariff FERC No. 125 has been updated to April 1, 2007.
- Also in FERC No. 125, Item 110 Determination of Volumes, the value of corrected volume has been changed. Plantation is increasing its loss allowance from 3/16 of 1% to 1/4 of 1%. This increase is necessary because of the losses associated with the new product grades required to meet federal and/or state regulations. Specifically changes in reformulated gasoline and sulfur levels in on-road and off-road diesel products. These changes to the product specifications have created additional downgrades and expenses.
- The distillate surcharge of 15 cpb at Chattanooga and Knoxville, TN destinations as stated in the Local, Proportional and Volume Incentive Tariff FERC No. 126 under note ⑥ has been cancelled.

All rates in F.E.R.C. Nos. 125 and 126 that are not cancelled remain unchanged.

We are also enclosing herewith one additional copy of this transmittal, including all attachments, and respectfully request that it be stamped at the time of filing with the Commission's file stamp and returned for our records.
