Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (ICA) and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (F.E.R.C.), Plantation Pipe Line Company (Plantation) submits for filing four copies of the following tariff, effective August 1, 2007:

- F.E.R.C. No. 130, Local, Proportional and Volume Incentive Tariff (Cancels F.E.R.C. No. 127)

Plantation is filing this tariff to lower the incentive level of the Bengal ULSD Volume Incentive Program in Item 60. Currently the first incentive, Level A, starts at 8,000,000 ULSD barrels. Item 60.3 Level A has new language added which lowers the threshold level and reads as follows: "Level A – This incentive level applies to any Shipper who ships between 6,500,000 and 8,000,000 ULSD barrels during the Bengal VIP Term." All other levels and incentive rates shall remain the same.

By lowering the incentive level, the Bengal ULSD Volume Incentive Program will allow more Shippers to meet the lower minimum incentive level at a rate less than the current base rate, which has been set at the indexed ceiling. The base rates for this incentive are stated in FERC No. 130 under Item 10. Table of Local Rates for volumes delivered from Baton Rouge, LA (East Baton Rouge Parish). The base rates are the indexed ceiling rates.

In addition to lowering the incentive level, the Example stated in Item 60.4(2) has been changed to correctly reflect the Bengal VIP Term of December 1, 2006 to November 31, 2007. Original filing stated the first month as November which is incorrect since the Bengal VIP Term started in December. The reference marks in Item 60.4(2) reflect the changes made to better reflect the Program.

We are also enclosing herewith one additional copy of this transmittal, including all attachments, and respectfully request that it be stamped at the time of filing with the Commission's file stamp and returned for our records.


