Dear Secretary Salas:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (ICA) and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (F.E.R.C.), Plantation Pipe Line Company (Plantation) submits for filing Supplement No. 1 to F.E.R.C. No. 122 (Correction Supplement) to be effective December 1, 2006 on 10 days notice.

This "Correction Supplement" is being filed to correct Item 60 sub-paragraph 60.3(1) Applicable Destinations of the Bengal Pipeline Origin ULSD Volume Incentive Program in FERC No. 122 under Docket No. IS07-31-000. Item 60 in the original filing erroneously stated Meridian, MS as an applicable destination. Supplement No. 1 to FERC No. 122 Item 60A deletes this destination. All rates in Item 60A are unchanged.

Plantation requests the waiver of the 30-day filing requirement pursuant to 6(3) of the ICA and 18 CFR § 341.14 to file Supplement No. 1 to FERC No. 122 on 10 day's notice to be effective December 1, 2006. In order to have the correction coincide with the effectiveness of FERC 122, Plantation seeks to have this Correction Supplement effective December 1, 2006. Plantation understands that Supplement No. 1 to FERC No. 122 is conditionally accepted subject to refund pending a 30-day review period.

We are also enclosing herewith one additional copy of this transmittal, including all attachments, and respectfully request that it be stamped at the time of filing with the Commission's file stamp and returned for our records.
