Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act (ICA) and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (F.E.R.C.), Plantation Pipe Line Company (Plantation) submits for filing four copies of the following tariffs, effective November 11, 2007:

- F.E.R.C. No. 131, Rules and Regulations (Cancels F.E.R.C. No. 125)
- F.E.R.C. No. 132, Local, Proportional and Volume Incentive Tariff (Cancels F.E.R.C. No. 130)
- F.E.R.C. No. 133, Joint Tariff with Marathon Pipe Line LLC (Cancels F.E.R.C. No. 128)

Plantation is making this filing to report on the completion of its security surcharge and cancellation of security surcharge items in the subject tariffs. In 2003 Plantation filed tariffs with the F.E.R.C. seeking and receiving approval for a security surcharge in Docket No. IS03-457-000. The security surcharge became effective September 1, 2003 and lasted 4 years, expiring on August 31, 2007 with the requirement to provide a final reconciliation and true up.

Plantation's final reconciliation and true up revealed an under-recovery of \$515,618; a per barrel rate of 0.06 cents as shown on the enclosed schedule. This under-recovered amount is due to lower pipeline volumes than previously anticipated. As provided for in Item 290 of Plantation's rules and regulations tariff (most recently FERC 125), the shippers were individually invoiced for their pro-rata portion of the under-recovery in September 2007.

The base rates in the above-proposed tariffs are unchanged from the prior tariffs, however, the security surcharge rates and related rules (Item 290) have been removed.

F.E.R.C. No. 133 is a joint tariff with Marathon Pipe Line LLC (MPL). The contact person at Marathon Pipe Line LLC is Debby Van Dine, Tariff Coordinator. Ms. Van Dine can be reached at (419) 421-4048 or at 539 South Main Street, Findlay, OH 45840.
